Walkways

Due to physical size constraints, it was not possible to include walkway markings on this decal sheet. They must be painted on by the modeler. Please carefully consult your references as to exact placement of the walkways on the Phantom you wish to model. They have a wide variety of placement and color patterns possible. When painting them onto your model, it is best to use a paint with a rough texture to simulate the texture of the walkways used on actual Phantoms.
