


Falcons Of The Red


LA-7 FLown by MaJ.V.A Orekhov. In Typical LA-7 colors of LT.& DK. Gray with Blue undersurfaces, this A/C wears a distinctive Red nose and spinners with oblique white Tail Stripes. Lithuanian Front.


2. This La-7 flown by Maj. A.V. A Lelyukhim over Berlin in the last days of the War, wears a camouflage of Lt. Gray and Lt. Blue with a Red nose and spinner. Donor inscriptions are Red only on the left side and Red/White on the right side. Nose emblem is on the left side and it is unknown if it was carried on the right side (supplied).



4. Maj. V.D. Lavrynyenkov flew this machine over Eastern Prussia during the Winter of 1944/45. This machine differs from our #2 A/C only in the color of the spinner which could have been Lt. Blue, White, or Natural Metal.







*** Note about the LA-7 ***

Notice that some La-7's have the Lavochkin emblem on the rudder tip and on the cowling. Many are provided, although we can only find one of these A/C wearing the emblem (A/C 5). The Academy/Hobbycraft kit is a very acceptable kit, deficient only in the vertical tail and the interior. We understand that accessories to correct these deficiencies will be available very shortly. Squadron canopies are also available for this kit.
